# Priority Point System

### Overview

The 35th Anniversary of OTC was another tremendous success, setting a record attendance of 50,921. OTC.04 attendees from over 100 nations around the world gathered at Reliant Center to learn and see the latest technology in the offshore oil and gas industry. The exhibition totaled 397,750 net square feet with over 2100 companies, divisions and subsidiaries represented.

In support of our exhibitors, it is the intent of OTC to provide a true and equitable space selection process. To maintain the integrity of the Priority Point System, OTC continually evaluates the process and makes adjustments as deemed necessary in the best interest of its exhibitors. The current system has been in place for two years, and it is the belief of OTC that the current system offers a fair and equitable process for all exhibitors.

### 2005 Priority Point System and Space Assignment Process

The OTC Priority Point System recognizes exhibitors who contribute to the success of OTC by providing a fair and equitable space assignment process. Exhibit space is assigned based on an exhibitor's previous participation.

All companies that have exhibited one or more years at OTC have earned a Historical Priority Number. All exhibitors participating at the OTC .04 earned an annual point award of 10 points regardless of size and/or location. This annual point award allows exhibiting companies an incentive to participate annually as well as the opportunity to continually improve their priority point ranking. In order to maintain their earned priority point number, exhibitors must participate once in a two-year period.

All exhibitors are notified, in writing, of the Space Assignment dates as well as provided a written copy of the Space Assignment Procedures. These procedures provide detailed information regarding the space assignment process and outlines specific deadlines.

Based on the final outcome of OTC .04, a complete listing of 2005 OTC Priority Point Numbers is included herein for your reference.

### Frequently Asked Questions

#### How is space assigned?

- Only companies submitting signed contracts with full deposits by 9 August 2004 are eligible for booth assignment by Priority Number.
- Companies submitting contracts and or deposits after 9 August 2004 will be assigned on a first-come first-served space available basis after all priority exhibitors have been assigned.
- Space will be assigned starting with the highest Priority Number (beginning with 1, 2, 3, etc.) and this process will continue until all received contracts have been assigned.
- If a selected space is not available, the policies outlined in the published Space Assignment Procedures will apply to all exhibitors.
- OTC shall assign exhibit space for the period of the 2005 Exhibition only and does not imply that the same or similar space will be held or offered for future shows.

#### How are points awarded to each exhibitor?

- All exhibiting companies earn ten (10) points per year for exhibiting, regardless of exhibit size and/or location.

#### What if an exhibitor decides not to participate for one year?

- To maintain an active Priority Number, all exhibiting companies are required to participate once in a two (2) year period.
- If a year is skipped, the exhibitor will retain all earned points to date, but will not earn additional points.

### **How is space selection handled for multiple divisions?**

- For each Priority Point Number, only one (1) contract can or will be executable.
- Exhibiting companies may allocate specific portions of the contracted space to its divisions.
- Points will be awarded to the contracted exhibiting company.
- Should a division choose not to exhibit with the company name on the contract the next year, said division will enter the Priority Point System as a new exhibitor.
- If a division and the parent company have separate Priority Numbers and exhibit under separate contract, space assignments will be made according to each separate Priority Number.

### **What happens to earned points when two companies decide to exhibit together?**

- Exhibiting companies are not allowed to combine Priority Numbers.
- The company with the highest Priority Number will retain the use of its Priority Number and the company with the lowest Priority Number will forfeit its Priority Number provided that a contract is not executed in its name within the two (2) year period.

### **What happens if a company decides to participate on their own?**

- Exhibiting companies who have been exhibiting with another company or International Stand and who do not have a Priority Number will be assigned the next available number in the sequence of priority numbers and will receive credit (3 points annually) for each year of participation.
- The individual company will be responsible for providing proof of participation with another company or International Stand to OTC.
- If the exhibiting company has a Priority Number and a contract is not executed within the two (2) year period, the exhibitor will forfeit its Priority Number.

### **How are ties broken when more than one exhibitor has the same number of points?**

- The date that the contract is received will determine priority.
- Should two contracts be received on the same date, the names of such exhibitors will be randomly drawn.

### **What happens to earned points if an exhibitor drops out of OTC?**

- Any exhibitor who does not participate once in a two (2) year period will forfeit all earned points.
- Exhibiting company's history will be erased and will be considered a new exhibitor should they decide to return to OTC.

### **How is space assigned for new exhibitors?**

- New exhibiting companies will be assigned on a first-come first-served space available basis.
- If a contract is received prior to the established Priority Number deadline, assignment will be made after all priority exhibitors are assigned.
- Submittal of contracts and/or deposits does not guarantee that space will be assigned.

### **How do I know if the space assignment process is fair to all exhibitors?**

- All exhibiting companies are notified, in writing, of the Space Assignment Date and Procedures.
- Initial space assignments are conducted at the OTC offices in Richardson, Texas, in the presence of OTC Senior Management.
- Upon actual space assignment, a Booth Confirmation Notice is sent to all exhibitors with complete details of assigned space.

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## 2005 Offshore Technology Conference Historical Priority List

The 2005 OTC Historical Priority List ranks companies in priority order based upon number of points accumulated regardless of square footage occupied/requested. All companies that have exhibited one (1) or more years at OTC have earned a Priority Number. Companies retain their priority ranking only if they participate at least once every two (2) years.
