



What to expect AT PASSPORT CONTROL

Because of existing regulations for passport and visa controls you may be subject to some or all of the following.

At primary passport inspection:

As you submit your passport, visa and related documentation to the Customs and Border Protection Inspector you may be subject to some of the following:

- Questions about your trip, country of origin, etc.
- Further detailed questions about you, your family history, etc.

After primary inspection and if the Customs and Border Protection Inspector so deems necessary, you may experience the following:

- Be forwarded to NSEERS (National Security Entry-Exit Registration System) Registration for further processing.
- Be forwarded to Secondary Screening for further questioning and/or additional document clarification.

Because of the anticipated high volume of international passengers, you may experience longer than normal waiting times at primary Passport inspection lines.

Please make note of the following:

- **You may shorten waiting times by properly completing all required immigration forms such as I-94 or I-94W, Customs declarations and NSEERS registration form (if applicable).**

If you need any assistance with these forms or help with any other matter, please look for the Houston Airport System OTC Help Desk at the International Arrivals area prior to passport inspection.
